

From Catremerio to the Lupi di Brembilla refuge

The hike starts in Catremerio, which can be reached from Sant'Antonio Abbandonato by carriage road. You can park in the square in front of the Centro d'Accoglienza house or at the edge of the road.



About 50 metres before the square, take the path marked C.A.I. 595 and follow it for a few minutes.



This section of the path is rough.



You come out onto an asphalt road, which you have to climb up for a short distance to where the path (C.A.I. signpost) turns left again.



You leave the road again and enter the forest.



After about 30', at a crossroads, we go left, following the indications on the C.A.I. signpost.



We follow the signposts.



Continuing on, we arrive at the "Spadì" rock shelter, characterised by a beautiful, well-preserved tree plantation.



Here we encounter a beautiful masonry roccolo.



Flanking the roccolo, the path passes near a small masonry house, with an adjacent hunting lodge, surrounded by gnarled and branching centuries-old beech trees, which protect us from the sun.



During the hunting season, the passage to the side of the house is impeded by a small gate, in which case we must descend to the left, for a few metres into the small valley and then climb back up to the right to resume the original path.



At a crossroads, turn left, following the indications on the C.A.I. signpost, and you will soon reach the ridge.

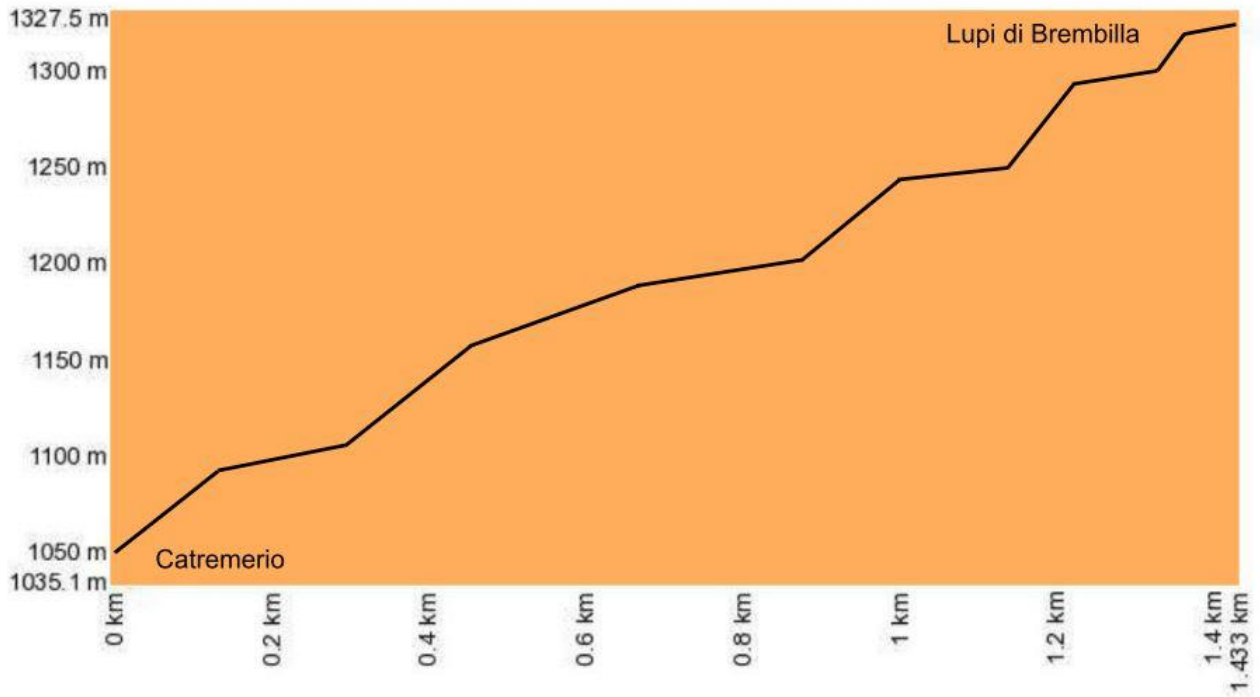


Proceeding to the left, in a few minutes of easy walking you reach the refuge (1260 m.). We pass the last signpost.



It is a beautiful refuge in a sunny position, just below the summit of Pizzo Cerro (1285 m.), when it is closed, you can stop by, using the tables and benches for picnics. The return is made by following the route of the ascent.
