For not many years now, the sanctuary has been accessible by car via the carriage road connecting Selvino with the Serina Valley. In the past, pilgrims used to climb up to the sanctuary along mule tracks, which are still well maintained today and are travelled by believers and visitors on recurring festivities. Easy mixed itinerary (dirt and asphalt) leading to the Santuario del Perello and back. Possibility of a more demanding variant by climbing to Salmeggia. This is one of the most classic excursions on the Plateau. One of these mule tracks, which can be followed without too much difficulty, starts in Selvino near the Palazzetto dello Sport, where you can park your car. A shady route suitable for particularly sunny days.



It starts in Selvino near the Palazzetto dello Sport in Selvino.



After parking the car, we start the route by leaving the beaten earth football pitch.



We walk past the signpost on a retaining wall on CAI path 514.



We pass a marker post.



We reach a section with wooden steps.



There is a wooden barrier along this stretch.



Now the path is without steps and with a compact surface.



We reach an equipped rest area.



The route continues without difficulty on a slight incline.



We are in the final stretch and the sanctuary will soon appear.



We are in sight of the Sanctuary of the Madonna del Perello.




We follow the indications on the signpost.



We reach and pass the bar placed on the asphalt road that will lead us towards the sanctuary. The current construction of the sanctuary of the Madonna del Perello dates back to the 16th century. On top of the small church that had already existed since the first half of the 15th century, two other churches of different sizes were later built, almost one on top of the other to form a large complex with a bell tower, two sacristies and the pilgrims' refreshment room. After a short refreshment, we resume our walk towards Selvino from where we started.
