The Conca del Farno can be reached by car from Barzizza, a hamlet of Gandino, along about 9 kilometres of tarmac road with some steep sections.



After passing the building of a former mountain colony, the car parks are found.



After parking, we begin the ascent along CAI path 545.



Along a fence, we see the signal flag.



At the end of the climb, we turn right to overcome the obstacle at the end of the asphalt stretch.



The route now continues on a surface of small stones and earth, and the ascent becomes less steep.



On the left we pass a well-kept house with a beautiful lawn.



At the crossroads, we continue to the right.



We reach a fork where, on the left, the path to Pizzo Formico.



On the right in the distance we see a waterhole that we will reach on our way.



A little further on, on the right, there is an information board full of information about the area, and an area equipped with tables and benches.



Continuing on, we reach Baita Cornei on the left.



We stop for a moment to refresh ourselves.



At the next fork we turn right onto the path to the Parafulmine refuge.




A few metres after the fork, we set off along CAI path 549.



Walking fairly easily along the path, we approach the waterhole on the right of the path, which we saw earlier.



In front of us we see the Baita Guazza Bassa.



We pass it and continue along the route.



The path enters the forest on a section full of stones and with cables on the downstream side.



We continue on and in the distance we see the roof of the Baroncelli Bivouac.



Descending on the left we reach the Tribulina della Guazza, which we pass on our right.



Continuing on the plateau, we see Bivacco Baroncelli on the left.



The small but cosy interior is well cared for.



We continue on our way following the information on the marker post.



In front of us is the Shepherds' Cross.



In this section, the route is exposed and great care must be taken.



After climbing up the other side of the valley, we continue to the left at the first fork.




After the marker we continue to the left.
